Bothriocephalus acheilognathi infection in Cichlids (*Aulonocara spp.*)

Abstract A flower-horn cichlid was 1.1 kilograms weight and 35 centimeters length. It showed lethargy, no swimming, anorexia, abdominal swelling, yellowish mucoid feces and patchy hemorrhage on abdomen and genital papillae. It was found including *Bothriocephalus acheilognathi* and secondary bacterial infection. It was treated by praziquantel and enrofloxacin. The fish had normal appetite, swimming behavior and the clinical sign recovered in 1 month after treatment.
