



Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Chiang Mai University Announcement
on
Ted Tesprateep Scholarship for the 2023 Academic Year

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Chiang Mai University (FVM-CMU) offers two Ph.D. scholarships in Doctor of philosophy Program in Veterinary Science, (International Program) for foreign lecturer/researcher who works in the university or academic institution, ranked at the position >500 by QS university world ranking 2023.

The aim of this scholarship is to provide tutorial and financial support for promising foreign lecturer/researcher who wishes to obtain a Ph.D. degree from the FVM-CMU through the submission of a dissertation and required to conduct their dissertation research under the supervision of the advisor at the FVM-CMU, expected to obtain their Ph.D. degree within a maximum period of three years.

Criteria and documents required for the scholarship application:

1. The applicant must be a foreign lecturer or researcher, employed full time at a foreign university or research institution, situated at >500 QS word ranking 2023 in his/her home country.
2. The applicant must hold a degree of Master of Sciences, Master of Veterinary Science or others that related to Veterinary Sciences.
3. The application must have at least an international publication in Scopus database.
4. Academic transcript (official English translation)
5. Copy of Passport
6. Certificate of English Language Proficiency issued not more than 2 years (on the date of application);
 - 5.1 TOEFL score 523 (Paper-based) or 193 (Computer-based)
or 69 (Internet-based)
 - 5.2 IELTS score of 5.5

7. Research Plan must be provided with a description 3-5 pages, explaining the study plan at Chiang Mai University and/or his/her own country. The applicant must contact in advance a professor at FVM-CMU in the field of intended study to initiate the research plan together.

8. Two recommendation letters; one of which must be from the current or latest applicant's major supervisor, and the other should be from the person most familiar with his/her scholarly work (recommendation letter from a professor at FVM-CMU, expected to be his/her dissertation supervisor, will receive a stronger consideration).

Scholarship Payment :

1. Tuition Fee: THB. 100,000 per semester/ THB. 600,000 per 3 years will be paid directly to the Program.
2. Travel expense:
 - 2.1 **Student:** A round trip economic air ticket (Home country – CMU – Home country); actual cost with a maximum of THB. 15,000.
 - 2.2 **FVM-CMU Advisor:** A round trip economic air ticket (CMU.– student's Home country – CMU); actual cost with a maximum of THB. 15,000.
3. Accommodation expenses:
 - 3.1 **Student:** THB. 5,000 per person in Chiang Mai stay (paid in lump sum).
 - 3.2 **FVM-CMU Advisor:** THB. 5,000 per person in student's home country (paid in lump sum).

Criteria and Conditions for Graduation:

1. The whole or part of the thesis must be published/accepted in an international journal with the student being the 1st author for at least 3 articles and must be in an ISI or Scopus (Q1 or Q2) database. The student must present part of the thesis as a poster or an oral presentation in an international conference at least 1 presentation.

Remark If any journal does not clearly specify “Original article” or “Research article”, the student must submit additional evidence/document/letter from the editor to declare the type of the paper.

2. The publications with the student as the first author must specify the "Ph.D. Program in Veterinary Science (International Program), Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Chiang Mai University, under the “Ted Tesprateep Scholarship” in the affiliation or acknowledgement.

1. Deceased
2. Resignation
3. Misbehavior
4. Any other reasons that the advisor has proposed to terminate the scholarship and the scholarship committee has approved the decision e.g. unable to study, not performing well, lack of study progress.
